Position Description:

The School of Business at Adams State University announces an opening for a position at the rank of Assistant/Associate Professor. This is a fulltime tenure-track position. We are seeking a faculty member to teach in Entrepreneurship and Marketing. The successful applicant will serve on the regular faculty of the School of Business. Adams State University is a state supported and federally designated Hispanic Serving Institution in the south central mountains of Colorado. The School of Business offers a collegial environment, a robust undergraduate curriculum in a student-centered environment, a diverse student population, and an expanding campus and distance education program.

Adams State University is located in historic Alamosa, Colorado, in the beautiful San Luis Valley between the San Juan and Sangre de Cristo mountain ranges. Wildlife abounds in the region and sometimes in town and on campus. The views from our 90 acre campus are stunning and nearby-outdoor recreation is easily found. The valley rests at 7500 feet and is the largest alpine valley in the United States. While Alamosa is a small rural

university town, we are just two hours from Santa Fe, New Mexico, 90 minutes from Taos, New Mexico, and 90 minutes to the I-25 corridor which takes you to Pueblo, Colorado Springs, and Denver.

Primary Responsibilities

- Regular teaching load is 4 courses per semester (12 semester hours) in undergraduate Entrepreneurship, Marketing, Management, and/or general business courses.
- Courses may include: Sales & Sales Management, Consumer Behavior, Business Ventures, Creativity & Innovation, Interactive/Social Media Marketing, Advertising, Marketing Research & Information, Marketing Management, Retailing, Sports Marketing, International Marketing, and Marketing in the 21st Century. Courses in general business may be requested and/or assigned as needed and appropriate, such as Introduction to Business, Business Statistics, Business Computer Applications, Business Communications, and Business Ethics & Decision Making.
- Non-teaching duties include advising students, participating in department and campus-wide committees, collaborating with faculty on School of Business programs; student club leadership and advocacy, and service to the campus and community.
- Develop a field of scholarship and/or creative contributions per the ASU Faculty Handbook,
- Maintain professional currency in the field of Entrepreneurship, Marketing, and general business.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Masters degree required in entrepreneurship, marketing, management, or other relevant business related field
- Work and leadership experience in entrepreneurship and/or marketing
- Experience in small business
- Interest and ability to create partnerships between ASU and local small businesses
- Ability to work in and support a team-oriented environment
- Understanding and support of the unique mission of Adams State University as an HSI, and as an open-enrollment university
- Demonstrated ability to work collegially and collaboratively with diverse internal and external constituencies
- Interest and willingness in living in rural Colorado
- Ability to perform the above duties

Other Preferred Qualifications:

- Terminal degree (PhD, DBA, etc.)

- A demonstrated record of teaching entrepreneurship and innovation
- Candidates with professional business experience

Rank/Salary

- Rank will be Assistant/Associate Professor, on probationary status beginning as "P1" per the Faculty Handbook.
- Salary is \$65,000-\$70,000 (academic year) with opportunities to supplement the salary with summer courses/workshops and distance education. Adams State University offers an excellent benefit package.
