

# Visiting Assistant Professor of Marketing

The Department of Economics and Management seeks an excellent teacher to fill a one-year assistant professor or instructor position in marketing beginning August 2019. The faculty member will teach three undergraduate courses per semester. Teaching assignments will include marketing principles, consumer behavior, marketing research, marketing strategy, and one or more electives in marketing, data analytics, or management. Preference will be given to a generalist able to teach a variety of undergraduate courses to students from diverse backgrounds. Applicants must provide evidence of effective teaching and must have at least a master's degree in a relevant field.

Approval is expected for a tenure track position to begin August 2020. The candidate selected for the one-year position would be eligible to be considered for the tenure track position.
