The Department of Management and Marketing, in the College of Business Administration and Information Sciences at Clarion University of Pennsylvania, invites applications for a tenure-track Assistant Professor of Marketing. Teaching assignments include undergraduate and graduate courses. Other responsibilities include, but are not limited to, research productivity at a level that satisfies AACSB requirements for faculty, advising students, and participating in departmental, college, and university committees.

Our teaching facilities currently allow for classes to be delivered via face-to-face, online, or ITV. We emphasize the applied method of teaching, using the profession's best practices throughout our curriculum. Our teaching load is four courses per semester with release time available for graduate teaching and research. Position is contingent on the availability of funding.

Required qualifications include a Ph.D. in Marketing or related field or ABD with significant progress toward completion of the degree. The successful completion of an on-campus interview, research presentation, and classroom demonstration is also required. A successful ABD candidate will be given two years to obtain a Ph.D. or will be subject to non-renewal. Preferred qualification include At least four years' experience in teaching at the college level plus a willingness to also teach Management and Human Resource Management courses as needed. Experience in teaching Marketing, Management, Operations, and Human Resource courses.

Clarion University, founded in 1867, is a master's comprehensive public university and part of the Pennsylvania State System of Higher Education. The University is located in northwestern PA, known for its natural beauty and outdoor activities, and is conveniently located off of I-80.
