Postdoctoral researchers will have completed a PhD in a field related to innovation management (such as, Business Administration, Economics, Healthcare Management/Health Sciences/Public Health, Industrial Engineering, Psychology, Sociology, etc.). Candidates will have demonstrated expertise in one or more empirical methodologies.

The position is a fixed-term appointment for the duration of three years, with an option to extend, pending a positive evaluation. A conversion to an indefinite position (tenure track) is not possible. Starting dates will be individually arranged. The successful candidate will work towards completion of a habilitation during the appointment. German civil service regulations will need to be met.

LMU Munich provides newly appointed faculty with various services, including welcome services and dual career support.
