The Assistant Professor's teaching responsibilities are assigned by the academic department head and may include serving as an academic advisor. The Assistant Professor engages in scholarly activities beyond those associated with teaching and is expected to demonstrate professional productivity in research, based upon the availability of resources and consistent with the mission of the University.

Description of Primary Duties Teach marketing courses in the primary area of Advertising and occasionally a principles of marketing class or consumer behavior. Conduct quality research leading to peer-reviewed, discipline-related publications. Provide service to the Department of Marketing, College of Business, Missouri State University, the local/regional community, and the profession.

Minimum Acceptable Qualifications The minimum acceptable qualifications for the position of Assistant Professor are prescribed in the Faculty Handbook. The ability to develop knowledge of, respect for, and skills to engage with those of other cultures or backgrounds is required.

Additional Qualifications The minimal acceptable qualifications are a Ph.D. in Business Administration from an AACSB accredited doctoral granting institution in Marketing or other closely related business field. Candidates may be ABD leading to completion of Ph.D., having previously mentioned qualifications, within one year. The assistant professor must have the ability to develop knowledge of, respect for, and skills to engage with those of other cultures or backgrounds.
