Assistant Professor of Marketing - Tenure Line

The Pennsylvania State University - Abington College invites applications for a tenure-track position in Marketing at the rank of Assistant Professor beginning in August 2019 with an ability to teach Principles of Marketing, Marketing Research, and Global Marketing among other courses. Competitive candidates will show evidence of research and publication productivity and a commitment to high quality instruction in a student-centered environment. The teaching load is three courses each semester, and the ability to teach both lower- and upper-division courses in traditional, hybrid, and on-line formats is highly desirable. Enthusiasm for working in a multidisciplinary environment is important. Candidates should have a Ph.D. in Marketing or a related discipline; applicants who are ABD but will complete their degree by Fall 2019 will be considered.
