The Department of Marketing in the Davis College of Business and Economics invites applications for an assistant professor tenure-track position in Marketing to begin August 2019. The position is subject to final authorization from the University. Requirements include an earned doctorate in marketing or a closely related discipline (or ABD status in final stage of degree completion). Given equality on other qualifications, preference will be given to applicants with an earned doctorate in marketing (or ABD status in final stage of degree completion) from an AACSB accredited college of business. A strong interest in undergraduate and graduate teaching, evidence of research potential, and a capacity to support efforts to enhance the marketing curriculum are expected. Salary and benefits are competitive and depend on the finalist's qualifications.

As a highly respected public institution, Radford University offers a diverse curriculum for over 9,900 undergraduate and 1,000 graduate students. Radford University is located in the City of Radford, Virginia (population 16,500), 36 miles southwest of Roanoke in the New River Valley (population 178,000), in the beautiful Blue Ridge Mountains. Radford is approximately 3-1/2 hours from Richmond, Virginia, less than 2 hours from Winston-Salem, North Carolina, and 4-1/2 hours from Washington, D.C.
