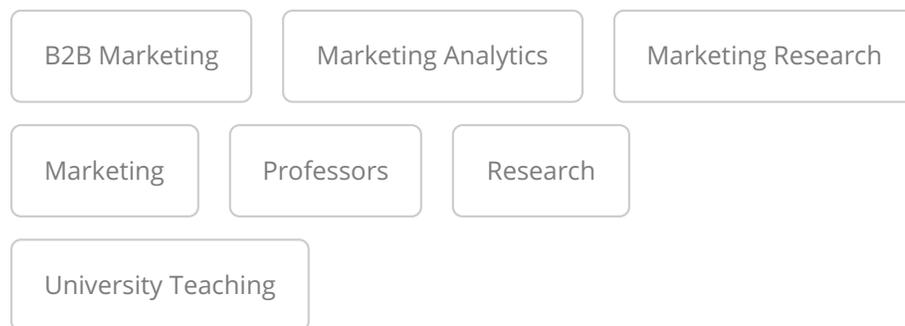
## Qualifications
