The Department of Management & Marketing in the John Massey School of Business at Southeastern Oklahoma State University invites applications for a tenure-track faculty position at the Assistant/Associate Professor rank. Candidates must be AACSB-qualified to teach in both Management and Marketing at the graduate and undergraduate level and be able to teach in face-to-face and online formats.

The applicant will teach 12 credit hours per semester, conduct and publish refereed research in the field of management or marketing, mentor students, and provide service to the department, school, university, community, and profession. Summer teaching has historically been available.

Minimum qualifications for an Assistant Professor position are a Ph.D or DBA in Management or Marketing or relevant field from an AACSB or ACBSP accredited program and a strong potential for and commitment to excellence in research and teaching. ABD candidates will be considered but must complete their degree by the start date. Candidates must have scholarly academic status according to AACSB standards.

Minimum qualifications for an Associate Professor position are a Ph.D or DBA in in Management or Marketing or relevant field from an AACSB or ACBSP accredited program and qualification as Scholarly Academic under AACSB criteria. Additionally, candidates must have a demonstrated record of high-quality research published in academic journals,

and excellence in teaching at the graduate and undergraduate level. Tenure is negotiable.

Founded in 1909, Southeastern Oklahoma State University enrolls approximately 3,900 students in 38 undergraduate and 14 graduate degree programs. The John Massey School of Business is managed with an open, integrated, and cross-discipline approach. Class sizes are small. The business programs are accredited by AACSB International. The School of Business offers degrees in accounting, finance, management, marketing, general business, and hospitality management and has a well-recognized online MBA program. The university is located in southeast Oklahoma, approximately 90 miles from the Dallas Metro area. The community is close to Lake Texoma and the Choctaw Casino Resort.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience. The preferred start date is January 2018 with a secondary start date of August 2018. Review of applications will begin November 27, 2017 and continue until the position is filled.

Employment is contingent upon the results of a national criminal and sex offender background check. Candidates must be eligible to work in the United States. Prior to issuing a letter of appointment, official transcripts must be received directly from each degree-granting institution by the Office of Academic Affairs.
