The Department of Marketing, within the School of Business at the University at Albany, State University of New York, invites applications for the position of Assistant Professor. This will be a tenure-track position, beginning September 2019.

Interest in teaching graduate and undergraduate courses in Marketing Strategy, Business-to-Business Marketing, and Sports/Entertainment Marketing is highly desired.

The position will require:

- Research in the area of Marketing and publication of such research in leading peer-reviewed journals
- High-quality teaching of Marketing and allied courses at graduate and undergraduate levels
- Service at the department, school, campus, and discipline levels

**Requirements:**

- Ph.D. or equivalent, with an emphasis in Marketing, from a college or university accredited by a U.S. Department of Education or internationally recognized organization by the time of appointment\*
- The ideal candidate will have evidence or demonstrated potential to publish research in leading journals.
- Candidates applying at the Advanced Assistant Professor level will have several years of experience at the Assistant Professor level at a major research university.
- Candidates applying at the Assistant Professor level will have noteworthy professional experience.
- Applicants must address in their application their ability to work with culturally diverse populations.

\*Candidates who will have completed their Ph.D. by Spring 2019 may be considered if they have had noteworthy professional experience.
