Additional Qualifications: Applicants must have a Ph.D. or equivalent degree in a closely-related field or have advanced to Ph.D. candidacy and will complete the doctoral degree or equivalent degree within 6 months of start date. Preferred qualifications: Candidates whose research, teaching, and service has prepared them to contribute to diversity and inclusion in higher education and to the Haas School's strategic focus on innovation, broadly defined, are encouraged to highlight these points in their application.
