The successful candidate will join a highly active and multidisciplinary group of faculty with research interests spanning various aspects of business analytics. The selected candidate is expected to play a major role in the functioning, growth and improvement of the MSBA program. Teaching responsibilities may span the MBA and MSBA programs. Recent graduates should show strong potential for top quality, innovative, and high-impact research in business analytics. Experienced candidates should have a record of high quality published or in-process research consistent with their experience. Candidates should hold a Ph.D. or expect to have completed a Ph.D. by the start of employment.

This position will remain open until filled.
