Applications are invited for a research assistant/associate position starting from 1 April 2017. The post-holder will be based in the Department of Psychology and will work with Dr William Skylark (Psychology) and Dr David Stillwell (Judge Business School) on a study of financial decision-making. The project involves a network of academics and industry partners and will entail close collaboration with the Cambridge Institute for Sustainability Leadership.

The successful candidate will be responsible for an experimental study of how information about the sustainability of investment products influences investment decisions. The research will involve both small-scale focus group work and a large-scale experimental study. Applicants must have or be near to completing a PhD in Behavioural Science (e.g., Psychology, Behavioural Economics) and have experience of programming, conducting, and analysing large-scale studies of human behaviour. Applicants should have excellent organisational and communication skills, and be able to work well as part of a team.

If you have an excellent background in experimental behavioural science and are keen to work on a project with real-world impact, we would very much like to hear from you.

The salary range if appointed as a Research Associate is £29,301 - £38,183 per annum and the salary range if appointed as Research Assistant is £25,298 - £29,301 per annum with promotion to Postdoctoral Research Associate on attainment of PhD.
