Description of Work The Department of Marketing in the College of Business at the University of Nebraska-Lincoln is seeking applicants for an Assistant Professor of Practice (PoP). Responsibilities would include 80% teaching (four sections each fall and spring semesters, or annual equivalent) and 20% service. This is a non-tenure leading position. A candidate with a doctorate will have a 10% research distribution of effort and 10% service, requiring some involvement in scholarly activities that demonstrate excellence in teaching. The successful candidate is expected to be significantly involved in the Department and College's teaching mission and teach a variety of courses at the undergraduate and graduate levels. In addition, the candidate will be expected to participate as appropriate, in the governance of the Department and College of Business, in academic policy making, and in a variety of non-class activities such as advising students and student organizations.

Minimum Required Qualifications Applicants must have a Master's degree.

Preferred Qualifications A Ph.D. or DBA with specialization in Marketing is preferred. Relevant professional experience is also preferred, especially for candidates who do not have a Ph.D. or DBA.
