The University of North Carolina at Pembroke's School of Business invites candidates for the position of Assistant or Associate Professor to teach undergraduate and MBA classes in marketing, including such courses as consumer behavior, retail management, personal selling and sales management, marketing research, and/or marketing strategy. The standard teaching load is 4 courses per semester, although a reduction to 3 courses per semester is granted for research activities. Course assignments may be during the daytime or evenings, and may include off-campus locations and online delivery.

Publication in peer reviewed journals is necessary to maintain AACSB Scholarly Academic (SA) status, and for tenure and promotion consideration. Service to the University/School/Department and the community is valued and required. Rank is open, but appointment at the assistant professor level is anticipated.

A doctoral degree in business administration, marketing, or closely related field, preferably from an AACSB-accredited institution; ability to provide teaching, research and service in a combination of organizational behavior, human resource management, and strategic management.

Applications will be accepted online only at <https://jobs.uncp.edu>. Applicants that apply on or before December 5, 2014 will receive initial consideration. Evidence of teaching effectiveness and scholarly work should be uploaded as part of the application process.

Official transcripts of all graduate work and three letters of reference will be requested from short-listed candidates.

If hired, the candidate will be required to submit proof of eligibility to work in the United States. New employees are paid only by direct deposit to the financial institution of their choice.
