The Marketing Department in the David Eccles School of Business at the University of Utah has an opening for one academically qualified full-time career-line (non-tenure-track) faculty member beginning Fall 2020. Candidates must have (1) a PhD in marketing or closely related field; (2) a substantial track record of exceptional teaching at the University level; (3) the ability to deliver classes in both marketing and sales; and (4) an established record of publication in leading academic marketing journals.
