A full-time, tenure track position at the assistant professor level in the area of Business/Marketing Education.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Required Qualifications:

- -An earned doctorate in curriculum and instruction, educational administration, career and technical education, or a closely related field. ABD accepted with expectation to complete by 8/23/2017.
- -A minimum of three years teaching experience in business education or business and marketing education at the middle-school or high-school level.
- -Evidence of scholarly productivity or a well-developed research agenda.

Desired Qualifications:

-Possess teaching experience at the post-secondary level in business and/or marketing education.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

Teaching graduate and undergraduate courses, advising, conducting educational research, supervising field experiences in business/marketing education, assisting in coordination of the business/marketing education licensure program, scholarship, and service. Possible graduate and undergraduate courses to be taught include: Methods of Teaching Basic Business Subjects; Introduction to Business and Marketing Education; Information Systems for Business Teachers; Principles of Career and Technical Education. Additionally, working directly with local schools, serving on faculty committees, grant writing and collaboration with faculty in multiple departments is expected. Experience working with diverse populations and a commitment to work with non-traditional students are essential to this position. Some travel may be required for this position. All faculty at UW-Whitewater may be required to teach online and hybrid courses, weekend and/or evening classes, and provide service to the university and local community in a variety of modalities, including leading Learning Communities, mentoring students, and providing professional development opportunities for colleagues.

DEPARTMENT INFORMATION:

The Curriculum and Instruction Department in the UW-Whitewater College of Education & Professional Studies (COEPS) provides students with the opportunity to prepare for careers as teachers. Students may choose the Early Childhood Program, the Elementary/Middle (MCEA) School Program or a Middle/Secondary School Program. In each of the programs, students earn Department of Public Instruction (DPI) licensure. As they move through their coursework, students combine a commitment to education with a strong liberal arts foundation, a teaching major and the study of teaching. All students engage in at least three school-based field experiences that allow them to apply their knowledge to actual classroom situations.

CAMPUS INFORMATION:

Founded in 1868, the University of Wisconsin-Whitewater is a regional comprehensive university with an enrollment of more than 12,000 students. UW-Whitewater has reached record enrollment four of the last five years and offers 50 majors in four colleges.
