

Clinical Assistant Professor in Marketing position will be available at Washington State University, Pullman beginning August 2019. Salary and benefits are competitive, and initial summer research support may be available for junior faculty. The responsibilities of this position include: academic research, teaching face-to-face and/or distance degree programs, and service. Faculty members must remain academically qualified (per AACSB standards for WSU) by performing academic research and publishing in the field's target journals. Faculty members are also expected to make significant contributions to their department, college, university, community, and profession. Normal teaching load is nine hours (3 courses per semester).

Candidates must possess a Ph.D. in Marketing or closely aligned field from a nationally or internationally recognized university by the employment start date. Candidates must have demonstrated commitment to excellence in teaching and teaching effectiveness and have demonstrated record of research published and current research targeted towards marketing journals. Preference will be given to candidates with research and teaching interests that are synergistic or compatible with the current faculty, international work experience, and is capable of teaching various undergraduate and graduate-level marketing courses. Research interests need not be directly related to teaching areas.

Applicants must provide a resume, teaching statement, recent teaching evaluations, and at least three (3) letters of reference before an application can be considered. Review of applications will begin May 1, 2019, and will continue until the position is filled.
