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A position as Assistant/Associate Professor in Marketing (full-time tenure-track) position will be available at Washington State University, Pullman beginning on August 16, 2017. Rank and salary are open, and benefits are competitive. Initial summer research support is normally available for more junior faculty; competitive summer research grants are also normally available. In addition, the department maintains a large, multifunctional behavior lab and subject pool for research purposes. The responsibilities of this position include: Teach (face-to-face and/or distance) courses in marketing, normal teaching load is six hours (2 courses per semester), actively involved with doctoral education, maintain an active research program targeting the field's premier journals, make service contributions to his/her department, college, university, community, and profession, and help further the research and teaching mission of the Carson College of Business.

Candidates must possess an appropriate doctorate in Marketing or closely aligned field from a nationally or internationally recognized university by September 1, 2017. Additional qualification of at least 6 years as an Assistant Professor or equivalent is required for Associate Professor. Demonstrated record of research published in, and current research targeted towards, the field's premier journals. Demonstrated commitment to excellence in teaching and teaching effectiveness. Preference will be given to candidates who will help build on the department's reputation in Marketing Strategy and Consumer Behavior, the preferred candidate must have demonstrated excellence in research related to either of these two broad research areas; capable of teaching marketing core and/or elective courses; demonstrated knowledge and excellence of teaching at the undergraduate level (for Assistant Professor) and/or MBA and Ph.D. courses (for Associate Professor).
