### Position Summary:

The School of Marketing, Entrepreneurship, Sport Management, and Hospitality & Tourism (housed in Western Carolina University's College of Business) invites applications for a tenure track position in marketing for fall 2020 at the assistant/associate professor level.

Teaching responsibilities include undergraduate and/or MBA marketing courses in the face-to-face and/or online setting. The normal teaching load is nine credit hours (three courses) per semester. The successful candidate must achieve and maintain "scholarly academic" status per AACSB requirements, which mandates a minimum level of relevant research and publication. In addition, the successful candidate will be responsible for serving on departmental, college, and university committees; advising marketing students; assisting with supervision of internships; effectively interfacing with the business community; and, performing other duties as assigned by the School Director.

Western Carolina University is AACSB accredited and its College of Business has over 60 full-time faculty members. The College currently offers undergraduate degrees in accounting, business administration & law, computer information systems, entrepreneurship, finance, hospitality & tourism, marketing, and sport management. It also offers graduate degrees in accountancy, business administration, entrepreneurship (online), sport management (online), and project management (online). Doctorate from AACSB-granting institution is preferred. Industry experience is desired. Preference may be given to candidates who have university level teaching experience.
