The successful candidate will have degrees and experience in marketing, data analytics, and business plan development. Other responsibilities include scholarly research and engaging in service for the school and college.

The primary responsibility of this role is to teach and mentor students in Westminster's Project-Based Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) and Master of Business Administration (MBA) programs. The Project-Based programs focus on mastering competencies through the submission of a series of project deliverables. Faculty members work directly with students to teach content and mentor both undergraduate and graduate students. The ability to work one-on-one with students and provide value-added feedback and support is essential for this position.

We seek candidates who are committed to quality teaching in a learning-focused environment, being active in research and publishing, and professionally engaged. This position is an 11-month contract. The successful candidate is expected to start August 1, 2020. Salary and benefits, including tuition remission, are competitive.

Minimum Qualifications

- A PhD in marketing with expertise in data analytics and business plan development. (ABDs may apply but final defense of the dissertation must be completed by July 2020).
- Demonstrated excellence in teaching is required.
- Must be currently qualified as Scholarly Academic per AACSB

- Relevant business and professional experience
